‘Adopt your local Fire Station!’

Would you be interested in ‘adopting’ your local fire station by providing chaplaincy support?

As the national chaplaincy to the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service, WPCS Chaplains provide chaplaincy support to many wholtime fire stations but many of the retained (P/T) or volunteer fire stations do not have a local Chaplain, especially in many rural areas. Part-time firefighters, often working in other occupations, are an essential link in the chain of support for emergencies and local community resilience. They are working with other community partners, some of whom are from local churches and chaplaincy is valued where it is provided.

Can you help us? We are looking to recruit local church leaders or lay people to become Volunteer Chaplains who have significant pastoral experience, are very good relationally, have excellent listening skills, and are passionate about service to the local community.

If you are interested in this community chaplaincy service to Wholtime or Retained or Voluntary stations, we are inviting you to attend any of following WPCS Training modules, especially the obligatory Foundation modules, for all new Volunteer Chaplains in the next couple of months. (We ask for a minimum period of service of around three years).
